⁴⁶ And Mary said:

55 to Abraham and his descendants forever, just as he promised our ancestors."

Luke 1:67-80 (NIV) Zechariah's Song

⁶⁷ His father Zechariah was filled with the Holy Spirit and prophesied:

68 "Praise be to the Lord, the God of Israel,

 $because\ he\ has\ come\ to\ his\ people\ and\ redeemed\ them.$

⁶⁹ He has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David

⁷⁰ (as he said through his holy prophets of long ago),

⁷¹ salvation from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us—

⁷² to show mercy to our ancestors and to remember his holy covenant,

the oath he swore to our father Abraham:

⁷⁴ to rescue us from the hand of our enemies, and to enable us to serve him without fear

in holiness and righteousness before him all our days.

⁷⁶ And you, my child, will be called a prophet of the Most High; for you will go on before the Lord to prepare the way for him,

⁷⁷ to give his people the knowledge of salvation through the forgiveness of their sins,

⁷⁸ because of the tender mercy of our God, by which the rising sun will come to us from heaven

⁷⁹ to shine on those living in darkness and in the shadow of death,

to guide our feet into the path of peace."

⁸⁰ And the child grew and became strong in spirit^[b]; and he lived in the wilderness until he appeared publicly to Israel.

Reflection questions:

- 1. Recall a memory when a song or storytelling was part of a meaningful event (funeral, baptism, birthday, routine part of day, etc.) that gave you/others hope? How did you see God working in your thought, actions, or attitudes?
- 2. You could say Mary's song, the *Magnificat*, addresses injustice, then and now. What particular people, places, causes, or circumstances are captive to injustice, that you know of? What comes to mind as you read Mary's song of hope?
- 3. What are carrying now that causes you to be weary, wary, or waiting? What brings you a "thrill of hope" during this Advent season? Write your own song/poem/story of hope as you wait on God for answers.
